



Parker Falls Homeowners Association Pool Rules

The pool facilities are private property owned by the PFHOA and are for the enjoyment of PFHOA homeowners, their families, and guests. To help keep the pool safe and enjoyable for everyone, it is not open to the public.

Please review the pool rules posted at the entrance and on the fence.

1. The pool is open from dawn to dusk.
2. Open the gate only for people you know are authorized to use the pool.
3. Keep the keypad code confidential and do not share it with others.
4. Guests are welcome when accompanied by a PFHOA family member.
5. No lifeguard on duty — swim at your own risk.
6. Shower before entering the pool.
7. Proper swim attire is required.
8. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
9. No running on the pool deck.
10. No diving in shallow areas.
11. No glass containers in the pool area.
12. No food or drinks in the pool.
13. An adult must always supervise minor children.
14. Non-swimmers should remain in designated shallow areas.
15. No one may enter the pool when there is thunder or lightning in the area.
16. No roughhousing, pushing, or horseplay.
17. Use respectful language and avoid disruptive behavior.
18. Keep noise at a respectful level so everyone can enjoy the pool.
19. No pets allowed in the pool area (except service animals where permitted).
20. Do not use the pool if you have a skin, eye, ear, or nasal infection.
21. Do not use the pool if you have a communicable disease.
22. Swim diapers are required for infants and toddlers.
23. No smoking or vaping in the pool area.
24. Avoid reserving pool furniture or moving it more than necessary.
25. Please clean up after yourself and dispose of trash properly.
26. Follow all posted signs and instructions.
27. Maximum occupancy limits must be followed.

28. If you play amplified music, please keep it at a volume that does not disturb others.
29. Pool gates must remain closed and always locked.
30. Emergency equipment is for emergencies only.
31. The Red phone is for emergency calls only.
32. Motorized recreational vehicles of any kind (e-bikes, e-scooters, etc.) are strictly prohibited in the pool area.
33. The emergency first aid kit is mounted on the wall of the women's restroom.
34. Reservations are not required for small parties or events. Please let the BOD know about your plans. The pool should remain open and welcoming to all members during events.
35. When using a BBQ grill, bring your own propane tank and move the grill away from the wall to avoid heat damage.
36. If someone is using the pool without authorization, please ask them to leave. If you need assistance, call the Wake County Sheriff's Department number listed on the entrance sign.
37. PFHOA reserves the right to deny anyone use of the pool at any time.

40. Acts of vandalism should be reported to the Wake County Sheriff's Department and will be prosecuted.
